Learning Program

We have six different swim stages. At the end of their lessons for each stage, every child is assessed, and there are multiple skills that have to be completed before they move onto the next stage.

We teach baby lessons for children aged 6 months to 3 years old every now and then, these lessons are not currently regular due to less instructors having the training to teach this age but we do try and put on a couple of taster lessons each year to give parents confidence as we have a lot of demand.



Seahorses - (our 3 and 4 year olds)

We include more singing, games, playtime, water confidence etc to give them the confidence to learn to swim, that's suited to their age. They will learn to put their faces in the water, float with support, jump with support, and learn all about pool safety'



Crabs (stage 1- any other age)

The Crab class is for anyone aged 5 years and above, and they will all usually be able to stand in the pool. They will learn to swim the width of the pool, as well as many other skills such as jumping and floating. This stage is one that many swimmers will repeat as going from no swim experience to swimming a width can take a lot of practice for some, and for others they will pick it up in a few swim sessions.



Turtles (stage 2)

Turtles will be confident at swimming the width, and most that pass into turtle are 7 years and over. They will learn how to swim the length of the pool, as well as treading water and sculling.



Jellyfish (stage 3)

Jellyfish will learn how to swim breast stroke, and also how to flop (an imitation of accidentally falling in) into the water and float to save themselves.



Dolphin (stage 4)

Dolphins will learn backstroke, better practice on their breathing whilst swimming, and the ability to change stroke, as well as swim for longer periods of time without stopping.



Sharks (stage 5)

Our last stage and more like our swim club, is for all children who have completed all previous stages. This stage is designed for them to have a place and space to come along and keep up the skills that they have learnt, whilst having supervision, as well as still feeling part of Likkle Swimmers. They will also learn some lifesaving with each other, in the hope they will be able to help others in the community if needed.

Learning Program








In 2023 we plan to expand Likkle Swimmers even further, and reach even more members of the community in Treasure Beach.

We will be hiring a Jamaican admin role within the team, who will be a local person who will spend time at the pool everyday when lessons are running. They will help take over day to day running tasks from Charlotte, and means that there will always be a friendly face at the pool. They will help with admin tasks, communicating with parents, taking photos and posting on our social media, supporting the teachers, managing our volunteers, helping keep the pool area tidy and organizing everything. We are really excited to welcome somebody into the team, and let you all know when we've found the right person!

We will also be flying out 2 STA trained swim teachers (Camilla and Adam) who will be training our 8 teachers with the STA international teacher qualification over a period of a week. This will give them all a much higher level of training, and a formal qualification, which will mean that Likkle Swimmers can keep improving.

We may also have a videographer flying out who will be making a film all about Likkle Swimmers in the hope

that we can spread awareness of what we are doing in the community.



Javin commented 'The private lesson have not been going bad at all, and should be considered as a success. It started off a bit slow at first, then grew to be more fruitful, as most businesses do. It may not be the case where all the swimmers are able to attend every week, but the progress in their learning is still visible when they do. It is expected that children who swim at a certain stage with me, will progress ahead of their peers due to improvement in the practicing. The vision of Likkle Swimmers family still stands strong, as children are now learning to swim during the Easter break, the summer break and basically the rest of the year now. Our impact on the community and others will stand for an eternity.'





SwimTayka



In 2022 we started our partnership with Swim Tayka whom we regard as like-minded and akin to our philosophy of making swimming available to all in the pursuit of reducing drowning incidents throughout the world.

They have helped us in many ways so far in expanding Likkle Swimmers and helping us to be more self sustainable in the future. One of the things Swim Tayka do is find and send out volunteers, who are qualified swim teachers, for two weeks each year. They support our Jamaican teachers by passing on knowledge and skills, whilst our Jamaican teachers can also share what they have learnt.

This year, we had our first 3 volunteers; Fiona, Becci and Laura. Cacona villa in Old Wharf, Treasure Beach was able to host them, and will host them next year as well, we are really thankful for their support.

Becci said "a life changing experience both for the children and for me. Such an honour to be able to help these kids."

Fiona said "It was an amazing experience to be part of, everyone was so friendly and welcoming, and the accommodation provided was stunning. We were able to share our skills and teaching practices with
